Hiking suggestions from front page:

#### Blue route: Asafossen Waterfall - viewpoint

Beautiful view of Åsafossen waterfall across Eide lake. Duration: Approx. 5-10 min stroll from the town centre.

#### Yellow route: Sengaberget - viewpoint

Easy walk through the village and a short hike on an uphill and uneven path. Fantastic views of the fjord, lake, mountains and Skjolden.

Duration: Approx. 1 h roundtrip. Parking is designated in the town center. Follow the signs from the town centre.

## Orange route: Rebni - viewpoint

Fantastic fjord view, fresh air, and peace and quiet, are good reasons to hike to Rebni mountain farm. The old farmer road serpentines upward to approx. 360 masl.

Duration: Approx. 3 h roundtrip. Parking is designated at the crossroads in the valley, as shown on the map. Follow the signs next to the road. Consider to extend the hike to Skåravatnet - Skjolden's most scenic viewpoint!

## 17. Drivande Waterfall

Refreshing and breathtaking! Those are the best words to describe this hidden gem of a waterfall. Drive, walk or bike 7 km into the Mørkrid valley and follow the sign to Åsetvatnet. Parking at the start of the path.

Duration: Approx. 1 h roundtrip.

## 11. Asafossen Waterfall

For those wanting to take a closer look, the sherpa-made path starts by the bridge and goes almost all the way into the waterfall! Parking at parking lot beside Vassbakken camping and restaurant.

Duration: Approx. 15 min. roundtrip.
